1st day. 3rd May. • Arrival at the school. Reception by the teachers and the school management team. Showing around the classrooms and school facilities. • Explanation of the programme of visits and tasks that will be carried out during job shadowing. • Visit to an Italian company where students can do their internships.

Afternoon: visit to Franciacorta together with Laura and Manila, meeting point at school at 13:10. Visit to CLARABELLA (<http://www.cascinaclarabella.it/cantina/clarabella-franciacorta/>), wine company focused on supporting people with psychological problems and working difficulties. Visiting the cellar, tasting Franciacorta wines and local finger food.

2nd day. 4th May. • Study of the implementation of the mediation programme, explaining WSS (world school style debating) rules as means of learning how to mediate • Discussing attention to diversity in Vocational Training and the strategies for the inclusion of students with support needs in the Italian educational system. Getting the necessary practical training for students to be able to carry out their training in workplaces in Italian companies through Erasmus+. **Afternoon:** visit to Sirmione meeting point at school at 13 In Sirmione we'll visit:

1. SCALIGERO CASTLE

Scaligero Castle, also called Castello Scaligero di Sirmione, is a fortress that dates back to the 14th century. It is one of Italy's best preserved castles.

2. THE HISTORIC CITY CENTER

The city center of Sirmione is a maze of narrow streets that is a delight to explore. These streets are filled with cafes (**Flower House**, a small café that is blanketed with purple bougainvillea), shops, bars, and hotels. It takes about an hour to walk through the city center, longer depending on how much shopping or dining you do along the way.

3. STEP INSIDE THE CHURCH OF SANTA MARIA DELLA NEVE

Located in the historic city center of Sirmione, this church, which is also known as Santa Maria Maggiore Church, dates back to the 15th century. Just inside, in the portico, is a column with a Roman milestone with a dedication to Emperor Julian the Apostate. The church is home to frescoes and a wooden statue of the Madonna.

4. JAMAICA BEACH

Jamaica Beach is the tip of the Sirmione peninsula. This "beach" is made up of wide, smooth rocks...it's not a sandy beach that one might expect.

5. TOUR THE GROTTA DE CATULLO

In the 1st century BC, a Roman villa was built on the Sirmio peninsula, not far from Jamaica Beach. It was occupied for several hundred years and then abandoned. In the 15th century, excavations began and this site has been the subject of academic research since this time. The villa gets its name because one of Catullus's poems describes his return to a villa in Sirmione. This archaeological site covers 20,000 square meters (two hectares) and it takes about an hour to tour the site.

6. CHURCH OF SAN PIETRO IN MAVINO

Just a short walk from Grotto de Cattulus is Sirmione's oldest church. The bell tower dates back to 1070 and the frescoes on the interior of the church date back to the 12th to 16th centuries.

3rd day. 5th May. • Attending a full day conference and workshops: "Mediation and Restorative Justice"

Evening: tour of the city and dinner all together: meeting point Abba-Ballini at 18:30

4th day. 6th May. • Explanation of the documents and computer programmes used for office management in an Italian company. • Attendance at lessons where pupils study Administration and Management, possible collaboration agreements between both schools. • Farewell.
