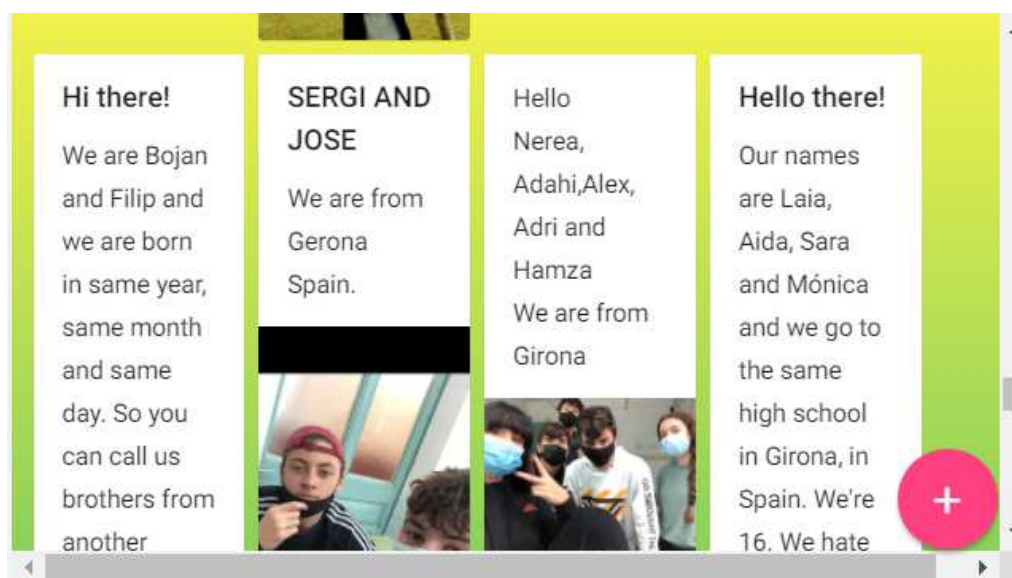

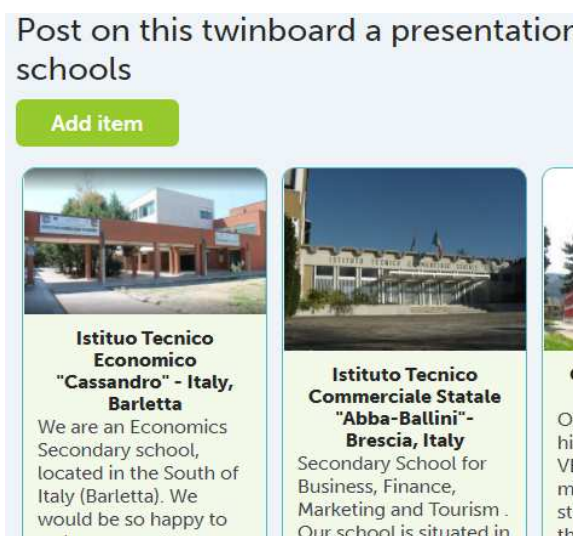

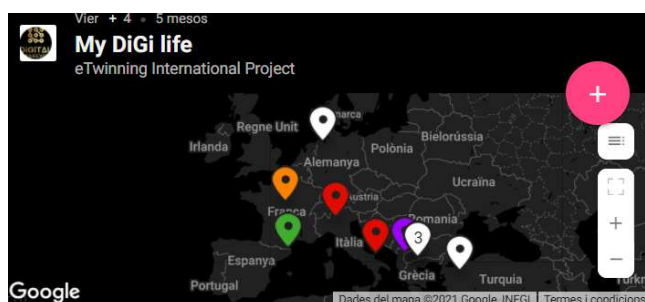

COPYRIGHT

Present students different kinds of Creative Commons licences and make them aware of the conditions that must be respected when reusing other people's creations like: images, videos or music.

Chapter 2: My rights and responsibilities

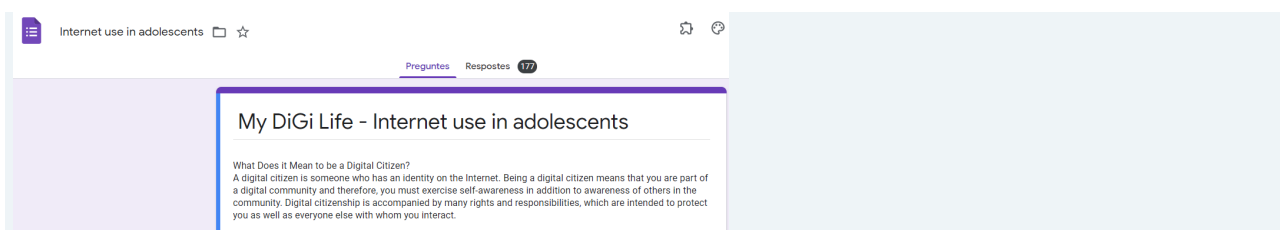
Dear students, Activity 2 will be an engaging one!
